## **Uniform Policy 2019**

Items listed as 'Holy Family School' are branded items displaying the school logo.

**Holy Family School Blazer: For all students**, which may be removed in lessons at the teacher's discretion, Year 11 will continue to wear a blazer, and must do so for arriving/leaving school and formal occasions such as assemblies, but optional for at other times.

**Holy Family School V-neck Jumper**: Year 11 will be permitted to wear a black V-neck school jumper during the next academic year. Other students will wear a plain, grey V-neck school jumper with logo.

Plain, White Shirt: Tucked in at all times and should not be too tight.

Holy Family Tie: Done up to the collar, worn to a sensible length and top button must be fastened.

School Coats: Not in place of school blazers and not to be worn inside the school building. Denim jackets, tracksuit tops, hoodies, sweatshirts and other non-uniform items should not be worn.

**Plain, Black School Trousers:** Trousers are not to be fashion trousers, jeans, tight around the legs, lycra, or lycra-style stretchy material, have external zips or be leggings style and must have sufficient fabric so as to be able to hang away from the leg. (Appendix I)

**Holy Family School Knee Length Skirt:** Skirts with slits or which are too short or tight are not permitted.

Plain Black Tights or Socks: These must have no patterns and must adequately cover ankles.

Plain Black School Shoes: Formal leather or faux leather style with black sole and without logos or markings. Boots, trainer style shoes, pumps, backless slip-on shoes or shoes with additional jewellery are not permitted. Should any student have a medical note from a doctor, please contact the relevant Year Leader to discuss these arrangements. (Appendix II)

Accessories: Plain black belt with a small, plain buckle is allowed. Large or fashion belts are not permitted. Hats and caps are not allowed in school, as are no other accessories to uniform.

Light Make Up: Key Stage 4 (Years 9, 10 and 11) are permitted the discreet use of light foundation. Lipstick, eye shadow, eye liner, false eye lashes, fake tan and fake, coloured or long nails are not.

Jewellery: One pair of small round gold or silver studs in ear lobes only. Body and facial piercings, rings, bands, and bracelets are not permitted, including coming into or leaving school, and will be confiscated until a parent or guardian can collect them. Students are allowed a wrist watch, however, the use of smart watches for communication is not allowed. Parents/carers/guardians need to be aware and carefully consider the timing if they give permission to their child to have piercings to allow the 'healing period' to be achieved in order to meet these requirements in school.

Moderate Hairstyles: Hairstyles shorter than grade 2 or with large variations in length, lines, patterns, contrasting colouring or colours not considered to be natural are not permitted. Students who do present with hairstyles outside of those allowed will spend their break and lunchtimes in isolation and will not be allowed to participate in official school photographs.

Students in incorrect uniform will be offered the chance to change into school-owned uniform. Refusal to comply will lead to isolation and a parent/guardian bringing in the correct items. Students refusing to comply will be treated as defiant and dealt with in line with our behaviour policy.

**PE Uniform** (See Appendix I)

All items are provided with Holy Family School Badge and Optional Student Initials: (Appendix III)

**Holy Family School Top**: Unisex 1/4 zip top, and a unisex standard T shirt/polo shirt or girls fitted polo shirt.

**Holy Family School Shorts or Tracksuit:** Unisex sports shorts or skort, sports leggings (optional), or tracksuit bottoms (optional).

Holy Family School Socks: Colour matched sports socks.

In Key Stage 4, branded PE kit will be for GCSE groups and/or those participating in sports teams. Students only partaking in core PE may continue to wear the school top, plain blue shorts or plain blue leggings/tracksuit bottoms and a plain white top. Logos and brands are not permitted on any PE kit.

If your child is unable to take part in PE due to medical reasons please provide a note via their School Planner. Your child is expected to bring their PE kit regardless of participation as their learning may take place through participation as a coach or official.

PE kit must be marked with the pupil's full name, however, the use of optional initials on garments should negate the need for this.
