Dear parents and carers,

This is the updated information we have been given today.

- We have been asked by North Yorkshire County Council to collate a list of our students whose parents and carers are key workers. Many thanks to those who responded today. When the new 'Key Worker' list is published we urge you to contact our enquiry email with details of your 'Key work' and your employer. Like you, we have been waiting for this list all day! enquiry@holyfamilycarlton.org
- We will be given more details of the **education provision** for Key Worker's children, across our area, when the local authority finalise the numbers involved. They are also working on transport, catering and cleaning.
- We have sent the list of our children who have EHCPs and those with social worker **support**. We are waiting for the local authority to confirm arrangements.
- We have followed the government advice to join the **voucher scheme** for families whose children are entitled to free school meals. We will contact eligible families as soon as we have access to the scheme.
- The Secretary of State for Education is due to give further clarity on the plans for **Year 11** tomorrow. We will inform you as soon as we receive this information.
- The **current advice** we have been given for our **Y11** students is to continue their studies until more detail is known. They have positively continued with assessments and work today. Their timetable tomorrow is focused on coursework elements which they may need to confirm grades.

Our students are **amazing** and have been a credit to you and this community. They have supported each other and have shown great maturity in their approach to national events.

We have reminded students of the school's online learning process. Access is via Classcharts, please see previous correspondence for details. They have been collecting their exercise books to take home.

We thank you for your patience and understanding. We will continue to update you as soon as we have any official confirmation of any arrangements.
