Supporting Online Learning

As ever we are grateful to all of you for your putting so much into supporting the efforts being made to provide our students with an online curriculum. Despite the name, GCSEPod is for **all students**, and whilst virtual classrooms can never fully replace the classroom with the encouragement and expertise our teachers provide, GCSEPod allows them to plan and provide video lessons and online assessments. This is replicating a classroom experience, currently being accessed over 500 times per day! A reminder of how to access GCSEPod, Kerboodle and Classcharts can be found at the side of this page.

You might have noticed that some lessons are now being set by teachers other than your child's subject teachers, and each week, rather than lesson by lesson. This is to allow students and parents greater flexibility to follow their timetable if preferred, or choose to work at different times throughout the week to free up time and resources at home between family members. You will also have seen that subjects are setting additional, and optional, 'Stretch & Challenge' lessons on ClassCharts. These are to allow students the opportunity to take part in some work of greater depth, or pre-learning in preparation for future studies.

As many of you are aware, staff have been contacting parents and guardians to ensure we are doing all we can to support the learning and well-being of students whilst they are accessing our online package. Over the coming week we are hoping to complete this task of contacting all of you for a catch -up chat and to highlight to us any concerns you or your child may be experiencing. This will also provide an opportunity for a brief discussion regarding how your child has been doing in school this year.
