Questions and Answers for this week

What is happening in September?

The guidance advice for how schools will be open 'full-time' in September will hopefully be out soon. We will be communicating with all students and parents/carers before we finish for the summer term to let you know the plans for September. Our online learning will continue to run for the next three weeks and teachers are continually checking progress to help them prepare the curriculum and learning plans for September.

Will schools be open for children over the summer?

It has been announced that schools are not open over the summer except where already used for 'summer programmes'. We will inform you, when details emerge, about any summer provision that is taking place in the Selby and Goole area.

Will there be free school meals vouchers over the summer?

The government has extended the scheme to provide vouchers for a further six weeks at the end of the summer term.

Essential Worker Provision: Our 'key school' provision will continue to run alongside the provision for Year 10. If you are an essential worker, or feel your child maybe vulnerable, and need your child to attend, please contact us. This is a legal safeguarding requirement to ensure we know who to expect each day, we cannot accept responsibility for children arriving without prior arrangement. If you are genuinely 'stuck' please make sure you message your teachers on classcharts.

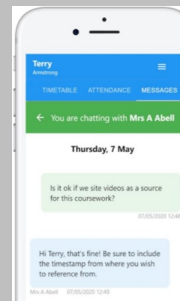
We miss you all every day and can't wait to see your 'smiles' again. It should not be long now before we can let you know the exact plans for September!
