As well as Year 11 taking their GCSE exams, our younger students in years 7 to 10 will be taking some end of year assessments before the 9th June. This will ensure that their new schools receive up to date information on their individual strengths and areas for development. In some subjects we will be combining the end of unit assessments from this year instead of a final assessment. Their receiving school will also have access to their KS2 data from primary school and we will be talking to staff at each school about friendship groups and other information.

Subject teachers will be putting information onto classcharts to let students know the topics covered in the assessments and they will be helping them to prepare during lessons. The SEND team will be supporting students with additional needs and adapting assessments where needed.

Message from Mrs Neal...


