Drowning Prevention Week

This week is Drowning Prevention Week. The <u>latest figures from the World Health</u>

Organization (WHO) estimate that 236,000 people drown every year, and it is among the leading causes of death for children aged five to fourteen.

In hot weather, open water can be tempting but it is also dangerous. We talked to our students today about ways to enjoy water safely in appropriate places and highlighted some of the dangers including cold water shock and hidden hazards. The key messages of the water safety code are simple but can be lifesaving:

- 1. Stop and Think Is it safe?
- 2. Stay together
- 3. Float to Live
- 4. Call 999 in an emergency
